ENERGY SAVING TIPS

- ADJUST YOUR WATER HEATER to 120 degrees to lower your water heating costs. Save \$12-\$30 annually for each 10 degrees F you reduce your water heater temperature.
- UPGRADE AND SAVE! Replace old inefficient boilers and hot water heaters with new energy efficient boilers (contact our office for current assistance programs).
- INCREASE YOUR R-FACTOR. Insulate floors, ceilings, and attics to save money and increase your comfort. R-38 insulation in the attic and R19 insulation in the subfloor is recommended. Caulk around windows to stop drafts.



CLEAN IS COOL! Vacuum your refrigerator coils (underneath and behind) once a year. The coils work best when clean and unobstructed - dissipating heat instead of using excessive electricity.

Automatic Delivery

Why you should consider automatic delivery

- If your tank gauge is faulty you may get a false reading and possibly run out.
- If a sudden cold snap hits, you may use more fuel in a shorter time than you had intended.
- No need to worry about running out of oil or watching your gauge.

POTENTIAL QUICK FIXES FOR LOSS OF HEAT



If you don't have heat, you may be able to fix the problem yourself and save time. Try these steps before you call us, and you may get your heat back immediately:

- Make sure that the oil burner emergency switch is in the "ON" position.
- Set the thermostat above room temperature.
- Check the fuel oil level gauge on your oil tank to be sure that the tank contains oil.
- Press the re-set button once only. If the burner does not start immediately, do not press the button again.
- If the burner or furnace does not run at all, check for a blown or loose fuse or a tripped circuit breaker.

If you have a steam heating system, check the water level and refill the boiler if needed.
